Background:

Bright youth forum (BYF) has come into being by few likeminded youth from Shangla and Kohistan while keeping in view the deteriorated condition of the area and the directionless youth. The objective behind the establishment of BYF is to use the youth for sustainable change and development in shangla and kohistan districts with an ultimate goal of having a just, fair, pluralistic and accountable society. BYF is formed for the capacity building of youth and identifying issues and their solution and eradication. The forum aims at creating awareness and establishing democratic norms and values among the youth in Shangla and Kohistan. The forum is tailored with keen exuberance to help the under privileged children to provide with better life through awareness raising, education and provision of basic amenities of life. BYF will extend its helping hands to the inhabitants of Shangla and Kohistan during natural calamities, disasters or unfortunate incidents through its pool of trained youth squad. BYF is taking political initiatives for learning and exploring the political system of Pakistan. The forum is developing new ideas for the districts while focusing social change and sustainable development. The forum is establishing debates for youth to train themselves with no tolerance for discrimination in the forum in any form.

Vision

BYF envisions having confident and resilient youth, a vibrant, just, caring, and tolerant, society.

Goal

Youth are well motivated as a catalyst for change and development in shangla and Kohistan.

The entire philosophy of BYF shall center round the following core values.

Scope of work

The scope of work of BYF consists on the following sectors.

- Youth capacity development in multi sectors with multi-dimensional skills.
- Awareness raising campaigns among the public in different sectors.
- Advocacy and lobbying campaigns for different rights based issues confronted by the youth and public at large.
- Debates on current local, regional and global issues.
- Speech debates among school and college students to develop their capacities.
- Quiz, naat, Qirat and Hamad competitions among the students.
- Sports Gala and events in different areas with intervals.
- Revival and promotion of local games.
- Local literature development through different events.
- Annual award giving ceremonies for writers, poets, singers, religious scholars, journalists, educationist and other society contributors.
- Giving out the awards to best performing students in different sectors on annual basis.
- Holding seminars on different topics at different places in the area.
- Eco-tourism development through linkages development with relevant public and private agencies.
- BYF is holding walks for awareness raising regarding different issues with different intervals throughout the years.
- Democracy, peace and justice are the central thematic areas of BYF and most of its programs will center round these things.
- Keeping in view the traditional society of the area BYF is planning to mediate different local conflicts through mediation, consultation and negotiation while using traditional and latest conflict resolution tools.
- BYF approaches to every issue in the light of law in constitution of the Islamic republic of Pakistan with rights based methodologies.
- BYF envisage connecting the youth and general public at large with the elected representatives through debates and discussions.

Geographical coverage

BYF is implementing its activities in par with its vision, mission, goal and programs in all the 67 union councils and 8 tehsils from the twin districts.

Mode of operation

BYF operates in the area through various multi sectorial activities carried out by volunteers and paid staff in collaboration with state and non-state actors. Its sustenance depends upon the donations from individuals and organizations.

Membership:

Eligibility:

- a) Any person having NIC of Pakistan.
- b) Any person of minimum 18 year old.
- c) Below 18 year will be registered through concern school.

- d) A person bearing good character.
- e) Every person will be register in the base of equality.
- f) A person follows the rules, regulation of forum.
- g) A person who can afford to pay the membership fee.

Membership Types:

General Membership:

- I. A person will be a general member of BYF if he/she agrees to pay the membership fee of RS.500 at the time of registration and a monthly fee of RS.300.
- II. Every general member is responsible to cooperate in every activity of the forum.
- III. In case of any emergency on the part of a member for not being able to participate in any planed activity, he/she will be relived on the condition of proper and timely intimation.

Founding Membership:

- I. A person will be a founding member of BYF if he/she agrees to pay the membership fee of RS.1000 at the time of registration and a monthly fee of RS.500.
- II. Founding members should be responsible to play key role in every activity of the forum.
- III. These members will plan all types of activities in the area for the forum.
- IV. These members will frame out the policies and procedures for BYF in collaboration with BoG.

School Membership:

- I. The registration fee for school is RS. 1500 (Fifteen Hundred only) and monthly donation is RS. 800 (Eight Hundred only).
- II. Forum will provide a registration certificate for registered schools.
- III. Every registered school will be eligible to participate in every activity with its own decision but the permission of forum is necessary.
